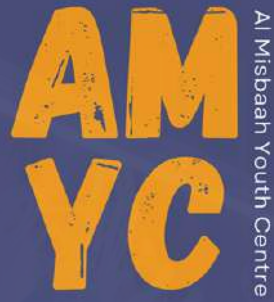

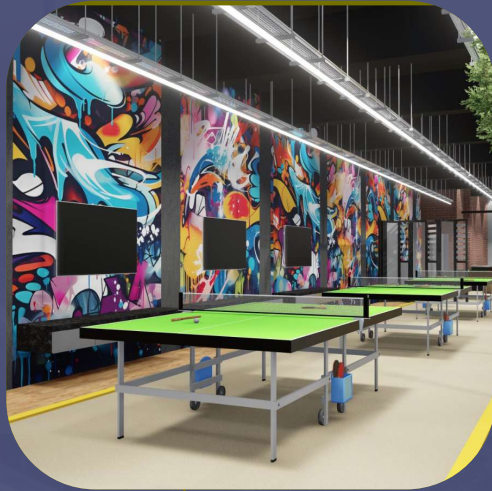

WALKING ON FLOWERS

EXCERPT TAKEN FROM ONE OF AL MISBAAH ACADEMY'S WEBINAR SERIES,
(KEYS TO SUCCESSFUL PARENTING DELIVERED BY SHAYKH HASAN ALI)

A story comes to my mind where there was a king. And this king wanted to always walk in his palace, in the courtyard, in the garden and so on. He wanted to walk always on clean ground. So his servants were continuously cleaning the ground. And he wanted to also walk where there's flowers. So wherever he would walk, there were servants that would throw some flowers on the ground so that his feet fell onto the flowers and he was completely clean. We're talking about 100% clean.

Now, this was a lot of effort to be made every single day to know where the king's going to walk, to make sure that the entire ground is clean. So one day one of his advisors just whispered in the king's ear and he said, 'King, I've got a wonderful idea.' The king said, 'What?' He said 'How about I make your life even more comfortable? How about I give you a pair of shoes?' So he gifted him a very nice pair of shoes and then the king wore them and he said, 'Now you can walk without having it in your mind that your feet are going to get dirt on them.'

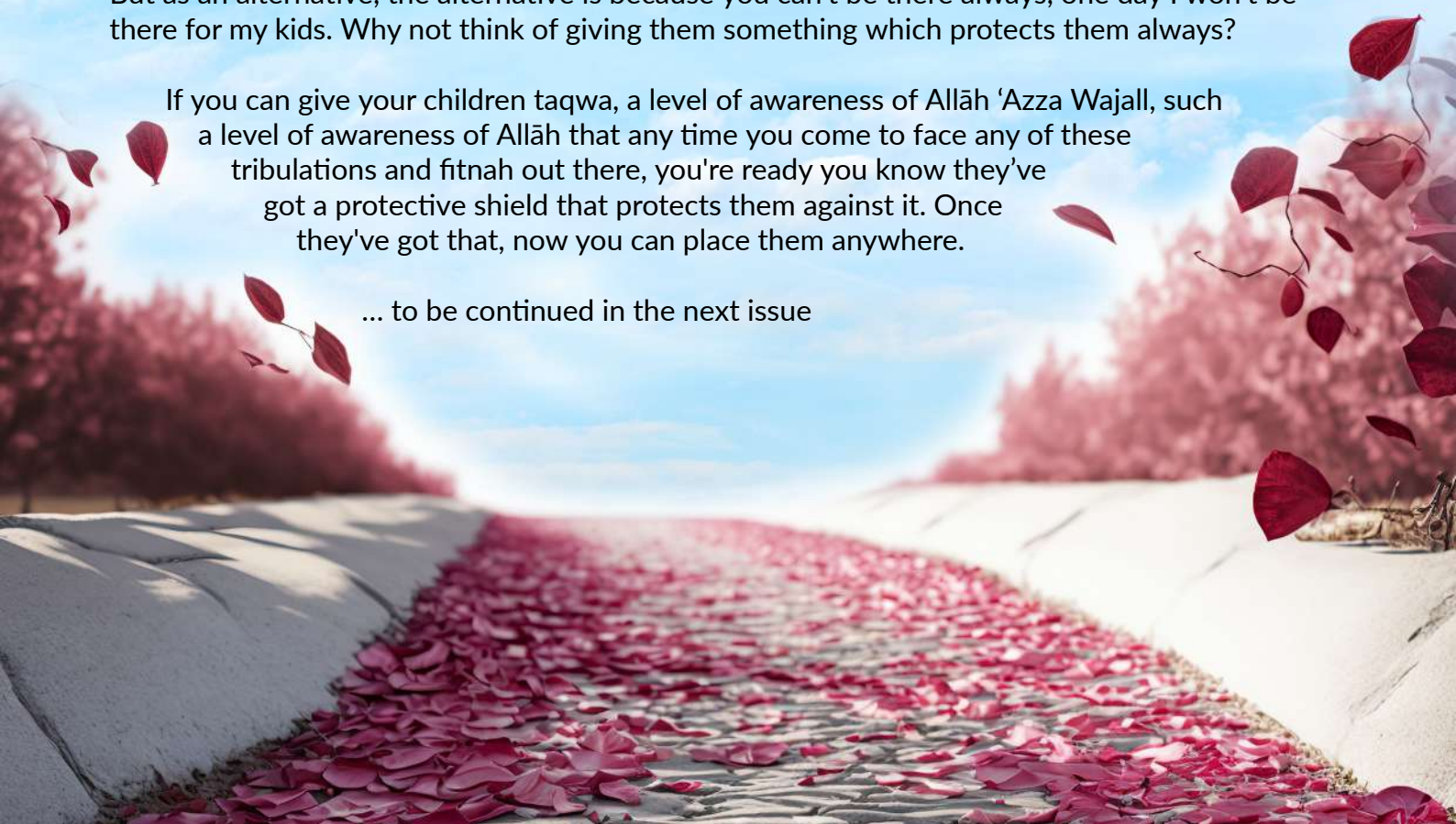
So what's the moral of the story? The moral of the story is that as parents, if you continue to think about your children and say, 'Oh my God, there's so many fitnah out there, how can I prevent these fitnah from getting to my children? And you're going to think about the fitnah of drugs, violence, foul language, relationships with different genders, the fitnah of kufr, of atheism, getting in bad company and so on and so forth!

So what you're trying to do is you're trying to save them from every single fitnah, as the king was doing with every single speck of dirt that is out there. He's trying to save himself from that. You're trying to create a world where none of these fitnah ever gets to them. And wherever they go, from beforehand, you've already planned. You can do that...

But as an alternative, the alternative is because you can't be there always, one day I won't be there for my kids. Why not think of giving them something which protects them always?

If you can give your children taqwa, a level of awareness of Allāh 'Azza Wajall, such a level of awareness of Allāh that any time you come to face any of these tribulations and fitnah out there, you're ready you know they've got a protective shield that protects them against it. Once they've got that, now you can place them anywhere.

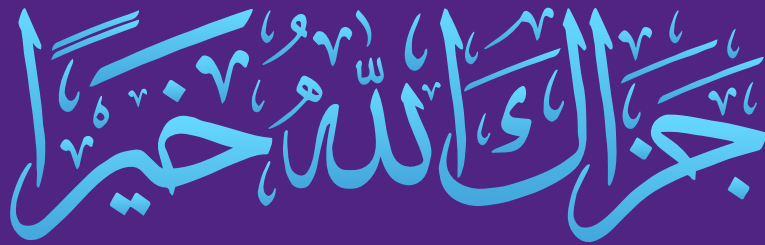
